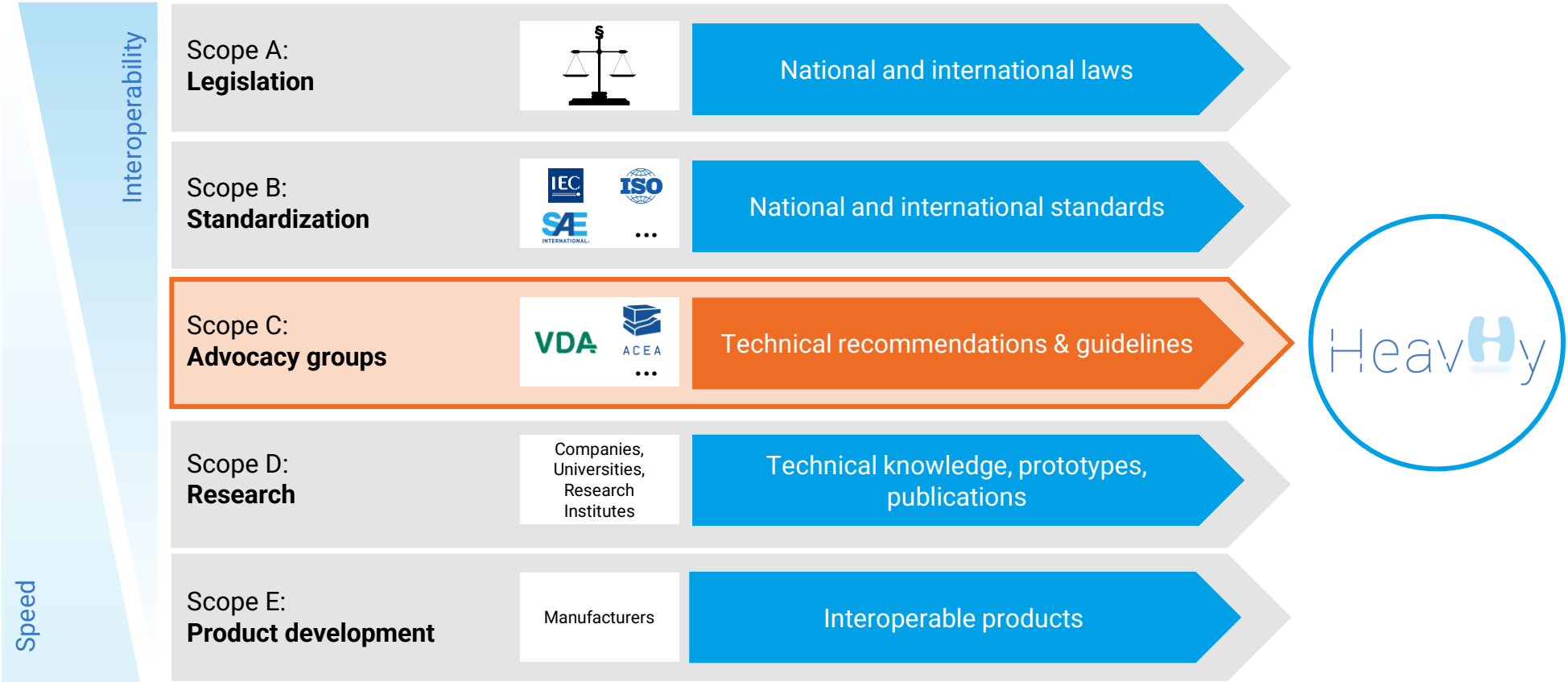


The H₂-Value Chain

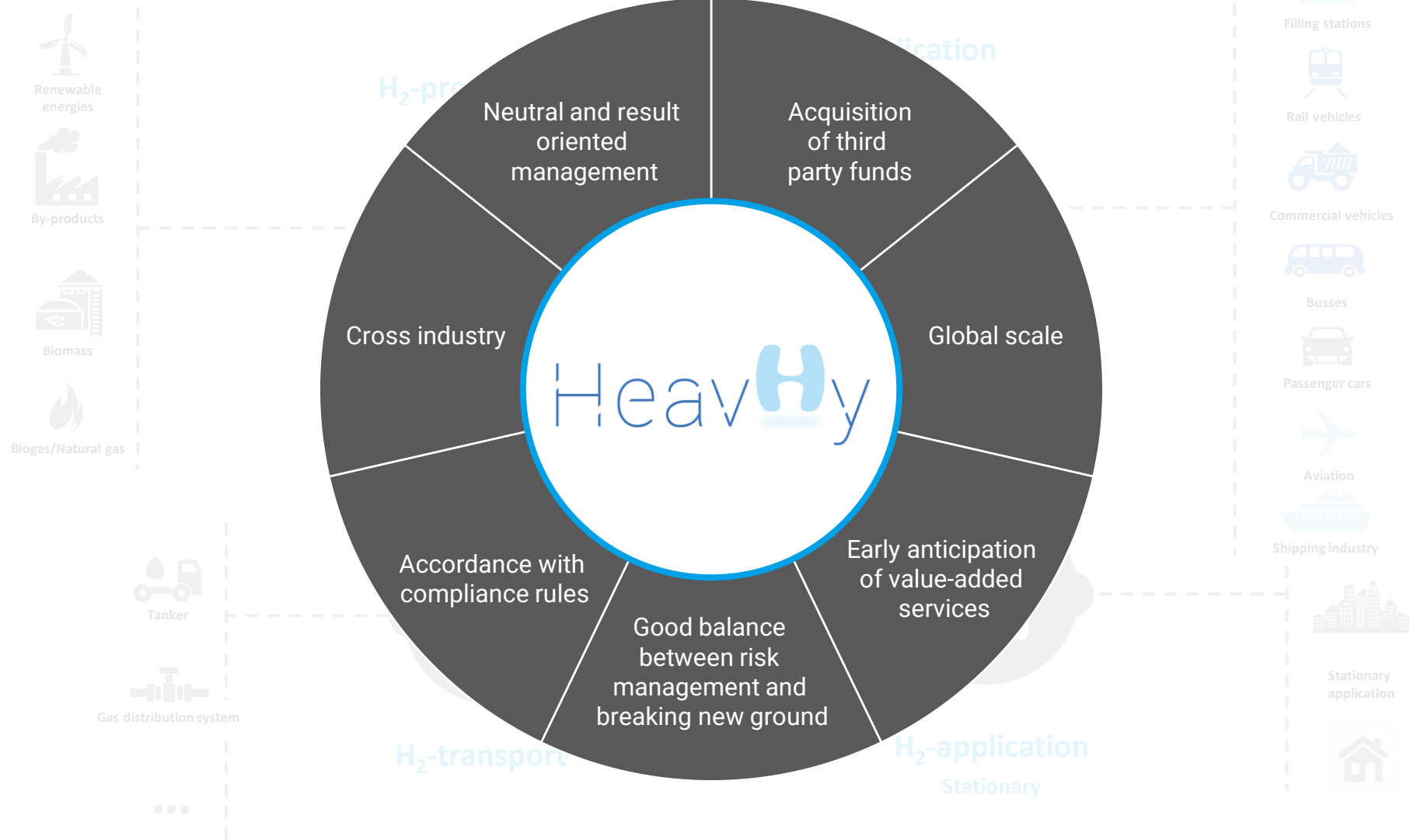

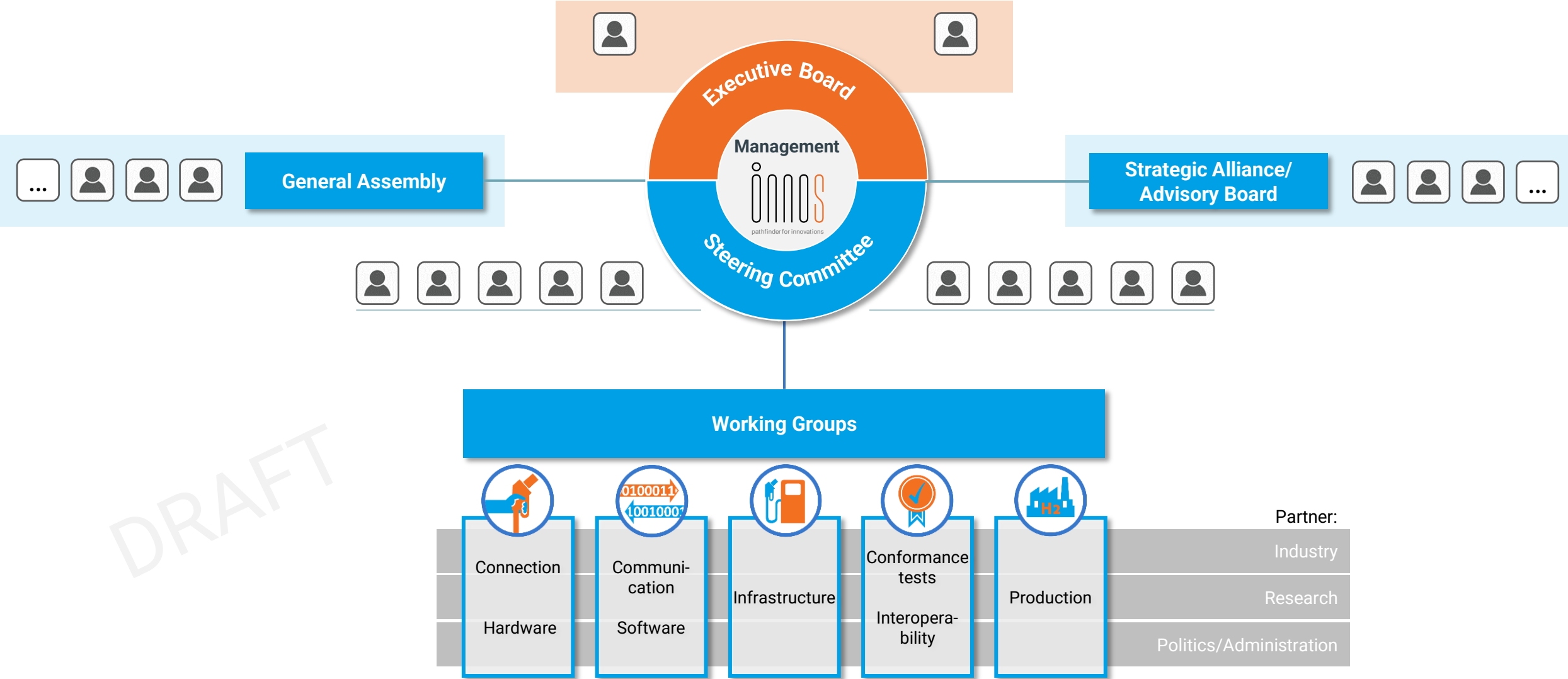
